

Enhancing and Extending Microsoft SharePoint 2013 for Secure Mobile Access and Email Management

SharePoint 2013 is the latest release of Microsoft's leading business collaboration platform, offering exciting new features for social networking, cloud integration, content management, and collaboration.

Since its introduction, SharePoint has delivered valuable out-of-the-box functionality, and then relied on partners and customers to extend or customize SharePoint to meet specific needs, such as business processes, records management, industry vertical support, and compliance.

The 2012 AIIM white paper, "The SharePoint Puzzle—adding the missing pieces" highlights the continued need for 3rd-party tools, stating, "SharePoint will continue to dominate ... with its position and strength being enhanced by the growing appreciation of it as a platform, not an application."

"As organizations understand that SharePoint operates best in this underlying platform mode, providing baseline collaboration, ECM and portal facilities, the adoption and implementation of third party add-ons will blossom, to enhance capabilities specific to particular business needs."

Colligo offers a complete solution for secure mobile SharePoint access and email management that extends the SharePoint platform to better meet the needs of the enterprise. With rich functionality, essential metadata support, multi-platform and multi-device support, an excellent UX, robust security, and granular administrative controls, Colligo apps are an essential adjunct to SharePoint 2013.

This whitepaper summarizes SharePoint 2013's new capabilities, and highlights the key areas in which Colligo delivers substantive business value over out-of-the-box SharePoint 2013.

SharePoint 2013 – What’s New?

SharePoint 2013 offers many new features; listed below are some highlights (Source: [Microsoft SharePoint Team Blog](#)):

- **Social Networking:** microblogging with sharing and following, newsfeeds, community, discussion, and blogs—these pervade SharePoint and offer new ways to collaborate
- **Discovery Centre:** site template for gathering discovery content
- **eDiscovery:** improved searching and export for both Exchange and SharePoint
- **Team Folders:** integration between Exchange and SharePoint
- **Search:** new faster architecture, plus personalized search and contextual preview
- **Site Mailboxes:** drag-and-drop integration of SharePoint 2013 and Outlook 2013
- **SkyDrive Pro:** storage, sync, and sharing for desktop and cloud, integrated with SharePoint
- **Task Management:** built-in task management, plus sync with Project Pro or use Project Online
- **SharePoint Sites:** the new Sites Hub streamlines the sites experience
- **Dynamic Publishing of Sites:** improved support for multiple devices and languages, and more
- **Cloud First:** the Cloud version will get new capabilities before the on-premises version
- **Cloud Apps Model:** build, deliver, and buy SharePoint apps on the new app Marketplace
- **UI Design:** the same clean flat appearance we see in Microsoft Office365

Extending SharePoint 2013 with Colligo

SharePoint 2013 has a number of enhancements aimed at improving out-of-the-box content management; for example, Site Mailboxes, SkyDrive Pro, Discovery Center, and eDiscovery. Each of these core functionalities can be extended with Colligo apps, to meet the business requirements of enterprise SharePoint deployments through increased productivity, streamlined collaboration and improved compliance.

The Backbone of Enterprise Content Management: Metadata

The enterprise value of content in SharePoint is largely a function of the metadata attached to it: good metadata makes it possible for people to get their work done more efficiently by being able to find the right content fast. Metadata is the key enabling attribute that unlocks access to content, without which content is expensive or impossible to find, and the implications for requirements such as compliance and records management can be disastrous.

Site Mailboxes: Tool that enables users to access both SharePoint 2013 documents and Exchange 2013 email using the same client interface. Site Mailboxes provide drag-and-drop for email and documents to SharePoint 2013, and targets light project management and team collaboration.

For enterprise-grade capabilities, Colligo delivers a comprehensive solution featuring: metadata and content type support; drag-and-drop; automatic email property extraction as metadata; UI support for large numbers of sites and folders; unified search with metadata support across SharePoint and Outlook; auto-extraction of essential email properties; full metadata tagging from Outlook; automatic duplicate suppression of email content when added to SharePoint from Outlook; and central administration using Colligo Administrator.

The Site Mailbox feature requires SharePoint 2013, Office (Outlook) 2013, and Exchange 2013. For organizations not ready to upgrade to the full 2013 Microsoft suite, Colligo email management apps support Outlook 2013/2010/2007, all versions of Exchange, and SharePoint 2013/2010/2007/Office 365.

SkyDrive Pro: Document storage service that organizations provision and manage for their users. Users can sync their work documents from SharePoint to the cloud and take documents offline. SkyDrive Pro's offline document synchronization replaces the same feature in the now deprecated SharePoint Workspace.

Colligo apps offer a compelling alternative to SkyDrive Pro, by delivering capabilities that are critical to enterprise use of SharePoint: full support for metadata and content types; powerful synchronization with user-controlled settings; support for check in/out from SharePoint; support for SharePoint calendars, lists, tasks, etc.; and cross-platform device support.

Discovery Center: Site template for creating sites that provides in-place hold, search, and export of content. Once a discovery project is completed, the site and its content can be released. Colligo apps are an excellent companion product to this new feature, as they drive the attachment of metadata, which in turn makes the discovery process faster, more effective and less costly.

eDiscovery: Search tool tuned to finding content for export from both SharePoint 2013 and Outlook 2013. As with the Discovery Center, Colligo apps are excellent companion products that ensure the content is accurately tagged and readily accessible.

The Missing Piece to the SharePoint 2013 Puzzle: Colligo Apps

Metadata: While SharePoint 2013 improves certain aspects of metadata over previous releases, addressing enterprise-grade requirements requires third-party tools. Colligo apps ensure proper tagging through industry-leading metadata support for every use case.

Mobile Device Support: SharePoint 2013 offers good mobile browser support, and for deploying SharePoint web solutions this is good news. However, users are demanding native apps for devices such as iOS-, Android-, and Windows-based smartphones and tablets, since they deliver a device-appropriate UX. Colligo Briefcase is available for iPad, iPhone, iPod Touch, and Android smartphones and tablets, PC, and Mac. Windows 8 Phone and Surface RT apps are planned for 2013.

Security: Whether it's a laptop, a smartphone or a tablet, devices can get lost or stolen. Without security measures in place, your IP, data, and other critical assets are at greater risk when stored on mobile devices. And since many devices to which your users will sync these assets are personal (BYOD), your

first line of defense is as poor as that user's device security habits, including weak, saved, or no device password and stored copies of content.

Colligo offers a number of security features including a separate enforceable passcode; automatic data wipe on 10-time passcode fail; jailbreak protection; MDM support; and more. These are essential security measures for any organization whose employees access corporate data on mobile devices.

Administration: In even modestly-sized organizations, the prospect of rolling out software to dozens or hundreds of devices can be daunting. Every app from Colligo can be managed through Colligo Administrator, to speed deployment, reduce IT overhead, and support corporate governance through centralized configuration, management, and reporting. Role- and policy-based access is centrally enforced, to ensure a consistent, secure experience, regardless of device.
